



# NJATC BLENDED LEARNING

**Construction Wireman/Construction Electrician (CWCE) online classes will be available soon.**

**Please follow these instructions to get started:**

1. Register at: [blendedlearning.njatc.org](http://blendedlearning.njatc.org)

This notifies the NMJATC online of CWCE's desired course(s).

2. Request for Access

Training Location: Click arrow on right, select New Mexico Electrical JATC

Password: IBEW-NECA

Type the two words shown in box below password, if unreadable, click refresh until readable.

Click Continue.

3. Request for Access - User Details

Type in your information as requested.

Desired Password: Used to gain access to blended learning site

Confirm Password: Retype password

Course Type: Click arrow on right, select Continuing Electrical Training

Requested Courses: Registered courses shown are offered by NJATC

Not all courses are available through the NMJATC all the time.

When sessions are scheduled notification will be emailed/mailed.

Check courses that interest you by clicking box(s) left of the course.

Would be a good idea to check all the courses.

Request Access: Click when courses are identified.

4. When NMJATC courses are scheduled and notification emailed/mailed, sign up for the classes as follows:

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## Class information and payment:

- Classes cost \$100 each and include textbook(s), online access to the workbook and assignments.
- Online work as well as lab class (es) are required to fine tune skills being taught through online study. Frequency and length of lab time varies with each class.
- Communication between instructor and student is accessed through the email given when registering. It is important to check your email daily to keep up with the class.
- Length of classes will be approximately 12 weeks.
- Anyone registering after class has started will be expected to catch up and be ready for the first lab Session as scheduled by the instructor.
- After satisfactorily completing, 400 Skills Based Credits will be awarded for each class.
- The NMJATC only accepts credit/debit cards, cashier's checks or money orders made out to JATC.
